# Neonatal Infant Pain Scale (NIPS)

> tight facial muscles; furrowed brow, chin, jaw

(negative facial expression – nose, mouth, brow)

(silent cry may be scored if baby is intubated as evidenced

> restful face, neutral expression

> mild moaning, intermittent

> loud scream; rising, shrill, continuous

by obvious mouth and facial movement)

> quiet, not crying

#### **Facial expression**

0 - relaxed muscles

1 – grimace

# Cry

0 – no cry 1 – whimper 2 – vigorous cry

### **Breathing pattern**

0 - relaxed> usual pattern for this infant1 - change in breathing> indrawing, irregular, faster than usual; gagging, breath holding

### Arms

0-relaxed/restrained	> no muscular rigidity; occasional random movements of arms
1 - flexed/extended	> tense, straight arms; rigid and/or rapid extension, flexion

#### Legs

0-relaxed/restrained	> no muscular rigidity; occasional random movements of legs
1 - flexed/extended	> tense, straight legs; rigid and/or rapid extension, flexion

## State of arousal

0 – sleeping/awake	> quiet, peaceful, sleeping or alert, random leg movements
1 – fussy	> alert, restless and thrashing
